May kindly see the property statement received online from Sri Abhishek Tripathi-II, Addl. Civil Judge (Junior Div.), Aligarh through which he has submitted his movable and immovable property statements held at the time of entering i.e., of joining into U.P. Judicial Service. His joining date is 16.11.2019.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement held at the time of joining into judicial service just after joining into Judicial Service. He has submitted the aforesaid statement through online dated 13.12.2021. As such, there is delay in submitting aforesaid property statements from the part of the officer. In this regard, the officer has stated in the attachment dated 10.12.2021 that (in officer's verbatim) "being a new entrant in the judicial service, I was not familiar with the requirement of rules that property statement is required to be sent at the time of joining by a judicial officer. Had I the idea of sending the property statement to the Hon'ble Court at the time of joining, I would have furnished the property statement to the Hon'ble Court beforehand. I most conscientiously assure the Hon'ble Court that henceforth no such lapse will ever take place on my part in future".

May, therefore, if approved, movable & immovable property statement at the time of entering i.e., of joining into U.P. Judicial service of Sri Abhishek Tripathi-II, Addl. Civil Judge (Junior Div.), Aligarh be laid before Hon'ble Mrs. Justice Sangeeta Chandra, Administrative Judge, Aligarh Judgeship for Her Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
