In this connection, it is submitted that officer has already submitted her property statement upto financial year 2018-19 which had already been Seen by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Mahesh Chandra Tripathi, the then Administrative Judge, Lucknow, in the old case id no. 5679.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit her property statement for the financial years 2019-21(2019-20 & 2020-21) its next financial year i.e., 2021-22 upto March 2022.
