May kindly see the online application dated 11.12.2021 by which Sushri Sangya Yaduvanshi, Addl. Civil Judge (Junior Div.) Meerut, has submitted her movable and immovable property statement held at the time of entering the Uttar Pradesh Judicial Services i.e her joining date 16.12.2019.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular letter, the officer has to submit property statement held at the time of joining the Uttar Pradesh Judicial Services on or just after the joining into the Uttar Pradesh Judicial Services. She has submitted the aforesaid property statement through her online request dated 11.12.2021. As such, there is delay in submitting the aforesaid statement from part of the officer for which she has mentioned that being a new entrant in the Judicial service, she was not familiar with the requirement of rules that property statement is required to be sent at the time of joining by a judicial officer. Had she the idea of sending property statement to the Hon'ble Court at the time of joining, she would have furnished the property statement to the Hon'ble Court beforehand. She most conscientiously assures the Hon'ble Court that henceforth no such lapse will ever take place on her part in future.
