May kindly see the property statement received online from Sri Arvind Kumar-II, Presiding Officer, Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Lalitpur regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family of the financial years 2016-18 (2016-17 & 2017-18) in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Hon'ble Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Hon'ble Court. In this connection, it is submitted that as per the statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2016-18 (2016-17 & 2017-18) of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by him are given below:

(1) In the financial years 2016-18 (2016-17 & 2017-18), Gross income from salary is Rs.30,96,063/-and total deductions/savings/repayment/investment against GPF, GIS, Income Tax, purchase of car, is Rs.21,03,203/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.9,92,860/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting of four members in both of the financial years. And the balance of his savings bank account(s) is also reduced by Rs.8,68,338/- in this financial year from previous year's balance.

In this connection, it is submitted that the Officer has submitted his property statements upto the financial years 2014-16 and the same has also been processed online against Case Id : P00046552021 before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Mayank Kumar Jain, Administrative Judge, Lalitpur Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement for the financial years 2016-18 (2016-17 & 2017-18) in its next financial year i.e., 2018-19 upto March 2019. He has submitted his movable and immovable property statements for the financial years 2016-18 (2016-17 & 2017-18) firstly vide online dated 15.12.21. As such, there is delay in submitting the same from the part of the officer. In this regard, the officer has apologized for the delay in submitting the property statement and requested to accept the same, as mentioned in his attachment letter.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements for the financial years 2016-18 (2016-17 & 2017-18) of Sri Arvind Kumar-II, Presiding Officer, Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Lalitpur, be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Mayank Kumar Jain, Administrative Judge, Lalitpur Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
