May kindly see the property statement received from Sri Sundar Pal, Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Deoria regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family for the financial years 2018-20 (2018-19 & 2019-20) in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2018-20 (2018-19 & 2019-20) of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by him are given below.

In the financial years 2018-20 (2018-19 & 2019-20), total income from salary is Rs.25,90,873/- and total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment (for both the financial years) against NPS, GIS, Income Tax, repayment of car & personal loan, PPF and Insurances, total of which is Rs.11,68,280/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.14,22,593/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting of four members in both the financial years and the balance of his savings bank account(s) is reduced for Rs.1883/- this financial year from previous year's balance

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has already submitted his property statement of the financial years 2016-18, which has already been processed before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rajnish Kumar, Administrative Judge, Deoria on old case Id no.829.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement of the financial years 2018-20 (2018-19 & 2019-20) in its next financial year i.e., 2018-19 upto March 2019. He has submitted movable and immovable property statements of the financial years 2018-20 (2018-19 & 2019-20) firstly vide online dated 16.12.2021. As such, there is delay in submitting the same from the part of the officer. In this regard, officer has mentioned that "very humbly it is being submitted that due to inadvertance, family issues and due to transfer of the officer from one station to other, the submission of the property statement got delayed. The officer deeply regrets and apologizes for the same.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements of the financial years 2018-20 (2018-19 & 2019-20) of Sri Sundar Pal, Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Deoria be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rajnish Kumar, Administrative Judge, Deoria for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
