May kindly see the online reply received from Smt. Nisha Ali, the then Judicial Magistrate, Saharanpur, presently posted as Judicial Magistrate, Auraiya, in compliance of order of Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rajiv Gupta, the then Administrative Judge, Saharanpur Judgeship in the matter of property statements held at the time of Joining in to U.P. Judicial Service, communicated to the officer.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer had submitted her movable & immovable property statements held at the time of Joining in to U.P. Judicial Service online dated 20.12.2021 on eServicesJO portal, which was put up before Hon'ble the then Administrative Judge, Saharanpur through detailed office note dated 23/07/2022, on which His Lordship has been pleased to pass the following order dated 22/03/2023:

"The officer be asked to submit explanation within fortnight regarding delayed submission of property statement."

The order of the Court had been communicated to the officer concerned on 23/03/2023.

In compliance of the Hon'ble Court's order, the Officer has submitted her explanation dated 01/04/2023, in which officer has stated that (verbatim):

"I joined the service on 16/12/2019 as Civil Judge Junior Division Fast track court. Sir, as I filed my property statement of the preceding year I was not aware of the time frame and directions of the Hon'ble High court regarding submission of property statement. In future I will be conscious and alert with regard to the submission of my property statement within the time frame and as per the directions of the Hon'ble High Court. Sir, kindly condone the delay."

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit her property statement held at the time of joining into judicial service just after joining into Judicial Service. Her joining date is 13/12/2019. She has submitted the aforesaid statement firstly on 20/12/2021. As such, there is delay in submitting aforesaid property statement from the part of the officer. In this regard, officer has given reason for delay and compliance the Hon'ble Court's order.

May therefore, if approved, movable & immovable property statement held at the time of Joining in to U.P. Judicial Service along-with the reply/ compliance of Hon'ble Court's order, as desired by the Court in the matter, furnished by Smt. Nisha Ali, Judicial Magistrate, Auraiya, be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Manish Kumar Nigam, Administrative Judge, Auraiya for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
