May kindly see the property statement online received from Sri Balram Das, Additional Civil Judge ( Senior Division)/ ACJM, Ayodhya regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family of the financial years 2018-20 (2018-19 & 2019-20) in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Hon'ble Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Hon'ble Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per the statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2018-20 (2018-19 & 2019-20) of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by him are given below:

In the financial years 2018-20 (2018-19 & 2019-20), his gross income from salary is Rs.20,62,091/and total deductions/Savings/investments against NPS, GIS, Income Tax, Insurances and repayment & down-payment of car loan are Rs.12,79,225/-. The balance of Rs.1,31,211/- has decreased from his saving bank A/c's against the balance of the previous year. Thus a sum of Rs.9,14,077/- (Rs.7,82,866/from salary and Rs.1,31,211/- from saving bank account withdrawal) was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting three members in the financial years 2018-20 (2018-19 & 2019-20).

It is pertinent to mention here that officer's wife (Registrar in Stamped and Registration Department) having annual income was Rs.5,13,470/- for the financial years 2018-19 & 2019-20.

In this connection, it is submitted that the Officer has already submitted his property statement for the financial years 2016-18 (2016-17 & 2017-18) online against case id-P00046582021 (old case id- 6815) and same has been processed before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Manish Mathur, Administrative Judge, Ayodhya Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement for the financial years 2018-20 (2018-19 & 2019-20) in its next financial year i.e., 2020-21 upto March 2021. He has submitted movable and immovable property statements for the financial years 2018-20 (2018-19 & 2019-20) vide online dated 22.12.2021. As such, there is delay in submitting the same. In this regard: officer verbatim " I apologies for late submission of property statement due to COVID 19Pandemic. Your Honour be please enough to accept it.."

May, therefore, if approved, property statements for the financial years 2018-20 (2018-19 & 2019-20) of Sri Balram Das, Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division)/ ACJM, Ayodhya be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Manish Mathur, Administrative Judge, Faizabad Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
