May kindly see the property statements online received from Smt. Neha Rungta, Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ghaziabad regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by her or any member of her family for the financial years 2016-17 & 2017-18 in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2016-17 & 2017-18 of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by her are given below.

(1) In the financial years 2016-18, total income is Rs.16,21,081/- (total Gross income from salary are Rs.15,64,864/-, interests income of Rs.56,217/-) and total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment (for both the financial years) against GIS, NPS, Income Tax, PPF, Insurance policies and the balance of her savings bank account(s) is enhanced for Rs.6,56,441/-, total of which is Rs.11,29,848/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.4,91,233/- was therefore available with her to meet out the household expenditure of herself in both the financial years.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has already submitted her property statement at the time of joining into Judicial Service which had already been seen by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Attau Rahman Masoodi, the then Administrative Judge, Ghaziabad on e-service ID no.P00054672022 and property statement of 2014-16 has been processed on e-service ID no.P00054682022.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit her property statement for the financial years 2016-17 & 2017-18 in its next financial year i.e., 2018-19 upto March 2019. She has submitted movable and immovable property statements for the financial years 2016-17 & 2017-18 vide online dated 08.03.2022. As such, there is delay in submitting the same from the part of the officer for which she has given the reason of delay that she was busy with excessive workload and other personal reasons, mentioned in remark column of movable proforma.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements for the financial years 2016-17 & 2017-18 of Smt. Neha Rungta, Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ghaziabad be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Saumitra Dayal Singh, Administrative Judge, Ghaziabad Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
