May kindly see the property statement received online from Smt. Indu Yadav, Civil Judge (Junior Div.), Lucknow regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by her or any member of her family for the financial year 2019-2021 (2019-20 & 2020-21) in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial year 2019-2021 (2019-20 & 2020-21) of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by her are given below:

**In the financial year 2019-2021 (2019-20 & 2020-21)**, the Gross income from salary is Rs.13,05,854/- and total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment against GIS, Income Tax, PPF and Loan Repayments are Rs.5,66,750/- and the balance of her savings bank account is also increased by Rs.173/- in this financial year from previous year's balance, total of which is Rs.5,66,923/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.7,38,931/- was therefore available with herself in the financial year 2019-2021 (2019-20 & 2020-21).

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has already submitted her movable and immovable property statements held at the time of joining into U.P. Judicial Service online against Case Id: P00011432021 (Old Case Id : 3241) and the same has been seen by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Abdul Moin, the then Administrative Judge, Basti Judgeship.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit her property statement for the financial year 2019-2021 (2019-20 & 2020-21) in its next financial year i.e., 2021-22 upto March 2022. She has firstly submitted movable and immovable property statements of the financial year 2019-2021 (2019-20 & 2020-21) vide online dated 01.04.2022. As such, there is one day delay in submitting the same from the part of the officer for which she has stated that "I was new in this service and then pandemic occurred. Due to bonafide mistake I was unaware about the urgency of submitting the property statement. I sincerely apologize for my mistake. I assure to not repeat same in my future", in the remark column.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements for the financial year 2019-2021 (2019-20 & 2020-21) of Smt. Indu Yadav, Civil Judge (Junior Div.), Lucknow, be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Kshitij Shailendra, Administrative Judge, Lucknow Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
