May kindly see the property statement submitted online from Sri Ranjeet Kumar Verma, Civil Judge (Junior Division), Lalitpur regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family for the financial year 2016-17 & 2017-18 in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2016-17 & 2017-18 of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by him are given below.

(1) In the financial year 2016-17 (i.e., from 11.01.2017 to 31.03.2017) & 2017-18, Gross income from salary is Rs.9,96,195/- and total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment NPS, GIS, Income Tax, Car loan, Personal loan and the balance of his savings bank account(s) is enhanced for Rs.606/- this financial year from previous year's balance, total of which is Rs.2,11,401/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.7,84,794/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of himself in the financial years 2016-17 (about 2.5 months) & 2017-18.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has already submitted his property statements at the time of entering into judicial service online on case-id no.P00060522022.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement of the financial years 2016-17 & 2017-18 in its next financial year i.e., 2018-19 upto March 2019. He has submitted movable and immovable property statements of the financial years 2016-17 & 2017-18 vide online dated 22.12.2022. As such, there is delay in submitting the same from the part of the officer for which he has stated that "initially, he was not aware of rules/ submitting proforma of property statements, after that he has distressed due to family problems and suspension on 23.03.2022 due to some service related issues and suspension has been over on 13.05.2022 and appointed in Lalitpur judgeship on 01.06.2022. He has also stated that he has not intended to disobey instructions of the Hon'ble High Court and requested with folded hands to accept the property statements" mentioned in his letter dated 21.12.2022, uploaded in the statement of 2020-2022.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements of the financial year 2016-17 & 2017-18 of Sri Ranjeet Kumar Verma, Civil Judge (Junior Division), Lalitpur be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Mayank Kumar Jain, Administrative Judge, Lalitpur Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
