May kindly see the property statement submitted online received from Sri Yogesh Jain, Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Meerut, regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family for the financial years 2020 - 2022 (2020-21 & 2021-22) in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Hon'ble Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statements of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2020 - 2022 (2020-21 & 2021-22) of the officer, concerned, details of income, deductions, savings, investment and expenditure made by him are given below.

In the financial year 2020 - 2022 (2020-21 & 2021-22), his total income from salary alongwith allowances is Rs.22,16,040/- and total deductions/savings/investments against NPS, GIS, Income Tax, PPF, Insurance Policies and SIP is Rs.18,51,049/-. Thus a sum of Rs.3,64,991/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting three members in both the financial years. And the balance of his savings bank account(s) is also reduced for Rs.4,11,604/- this financial year from previous year's balance.

It is pertinent to mention here that Rakesh Jain (Father) Document Writer in Tehsil Hodal District Palwal (Haryana) having annual income appx. 2,10,000/- Rs., Pawan Jain (Brother) working as doctor having annual income 6,00,000/- Rs. and Deepika Attri (Wife) working as Judicial Magistrate, Hathras having annual income Rs.10,41,219/- from salary.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has already submitted his property statements online upto the financial year 2018-20 which had already been processed online on case id no.P00062352022 before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Manish Mathur, Administrative Judge, Hathras .

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular letter, the officer has to submit his property statements for the financial years 2020 - 2022 (2020-21 & 2021-22) in its next financial year i.e., 2022-23 upto March 2023. He has submitted movable and immovable property statements for the financial years 2020 - 2022 (2020-21 & 2021-22) vide his online application dated 06.09.2022. As such, there is no delay in submitting the same from the part of the officer.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements for the financial years 2020 - 2022 (2020-21 & 2021-22) of Sri Yogesh Jain, Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Meerut, be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Saumitra Dayal Singh, Administrative Judge, Meerut for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
