May kindly see the property statement online received from Sri Amit Mani Tripathi, Additional Civil Judge (Junior Div.) Etah regarding submission of statement for movable and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family of the financial years 2019-21 (2019-20 & 2020-21) in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Hon'ble Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Hon'ble Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per the statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2019-21 (2019-20 & 2020-21) of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by him are given below:

**In the financial years 2019-21 (2019-20 & 2020-21)**, his gross income from salary is Rs.13,06,187/- and total deductions/Savings/investments against Income Tax, NSC, PPF and Repayment of Car Loan & down-payment are Rs.7,66,490/-. The balance of Rs.3,79,264/- has increased from his saving bank A/c's against the balance of the previous year. Thus a sum of Rs.5,39,697/-was therefore available himself to meet out the household expenditure for the financial years 2019-21 (2019-20 & 2020-21).

In this connection, it is submitted that the Officer has already submitted his property statement held at the time of Joining in to U.P. Judicial Service online against case id- P00001912021 (old case id-2178) , which had already been seen by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Piyush Agrawal, the then Administrative Judge, Mau Judgeship.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement for the financial years 2019-21 (2019-20 & 2020-21) in its next financial year i.e., 2021-22 upto March 2022. He has submitted movable and immovable property statements for the financial years 2019-21 (2019-20 & 2020-21) vide online dated 02.07.2022. As such, there is delay in submitting the same. In this regard officer verbatim; "This is my first posting i am very sorry for delay and assured that in future i shall keep myself more vigilant in sending property statement timely".

May, therefore, if approved, property statements for the financial years 2019-21 (2019-20 & 2020-21) of Sri Amit Mani Tripathi, Additional Civil Judge (Junior Div.) Etah be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Manish Kumar, Administrative Judge, Etah Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
