May kindly see the property statement received online from Smt. In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial year 2020-2022 (2020-21 & 2021-22) of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by her are given below:

In the financial year 2020-2022 (2020-21 & 2021-22), the Gross income from salary is Rs.43,05,156/- and total deductions/repayments/savings/investments against GIS, GPF, PPF, Insurances, Mutual Funds and Income Tax are Rs.21,32,143/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.21,73,013/- was therefore available with her to meet out the household expenditure of her family consisting four members in the financial year 2020-2022 (2020-21 & 2021-22) and the balance of her savings bank account is also decreased by Rs.73,458/- in this financial year from previous year's balance.

It is pertinent to mention here that her husband is a Judicial Officer having annual income of Rs.13,76,228/- & Rs.14,61,474/- for the financial year 2020-21 & 2021-22 respectively.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has already submitted her movable and immovable property statements of the financial year 2018-2020 (2018-19 & 2019-20), online against Case Id: P00005452020 (Old Case Id: 1293) and the same has been seen by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Mahesh Chandra Tripathi, the then Administrative Judge, Kanpur Nagar Judgeship.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit her property statement for the financial year 2020-2022 (2020-21 & 2021-22) in its next financial year i.e., 2022-23 upto March 2023. She has submitted movable and immovable property statements of the financial year 2020-2022 (2020-21 & 2021-22) vide online dated 05.11.2022. As such, there is no delay in submitting the same.
