May kindly see the online property statement received from Sri Manoj Kumar Agarwal, Principal Judge, Family Court, Aligarh regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family for the financial years 2020-22 (2020-21 & 2021-22) in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2020-22 (2020-21 & 2021-22) of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by him are given below.

(1) In the financial years 2020-22 (2020-21 & 2021-22), Total income is Rs.49,19,832/- (total Gross income is Rs.45,49,832/- & received from LIC policy of Rs.3,70,000/-) and total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment against GPF, GIS, Income Tax, Insurance policies, Loan and the balance of his savings bank account(s) is enhanced for Rs.7,95,976/- this financial year from previous year's balance, total of which is Rs.25,63,379/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.23,56,453/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting four members in both the financial years.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has already submitted his property statement upto the financial year 2018-20 which had already been seen online by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Vivek Chaudhary, the then Administrative Judge, Aligarh with the remark that "Let the property statements be kept on record. It is, however, expected from the Judicial Officer to submit his property statements well within time in future".

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement of the financial years 2020-22 (2020-21 & 2021-22) in its next financial year i.e., 2022-23 upto March 2023. He has submitted movable and immovable property statements of the financial year 2020-22 vide online dated 28.01.2023. As such, there is no delay in submitting the same.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements of the financial year 2020-22 (2020-21 & 2021-22) of Sri Manoj Kumar Agarwal, Principal Judge, Family Court, Aligarh be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Ajit Kumar, Administrative Judge, Aligarh Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
