May kindly see the online property statement received from Sri Sumit Kumar-II, Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Div.), Pratapgarh regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family for the financial years 2018-19 & 2019-20 in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2018-19 & 2019-20 of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by him are given below.

(1) In the financial years 2018-19 (i.e., from 13.06.2018 to 31.03.2019) & 2019-20, total Gross salary is Rs.17,47,929/- and total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment against GIS, NPS, Income Tax, Personal loan, Insurance policies and the balance of his savings bank account(s) has also been enhanced for Rs.76,650/- this financial year from previous year's balance, total of which is Rs.6,56,377/- . Thus, a sum of Rs.10,91,552/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting three members in both of the financial years.

It is pertinent to mention here that his mother's annual income of Rs.2-3 lacs from agriculture.

In this connection, it is submitted that officer has already submitted his property statement at the time of joining which had already been seen online by Hon'ble Mr. Justice J. J. Munir, the then Administrative Judge, Pratapgarh.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement for the financial year 2018-19 & 2019-20 in its next financial year i.e., 2020-21 upto March,2021. He has submitted movable and immovable property statements for the financial years 2018-20 firstly vide online dated 04.08.2023. As such, there is delay in submitting the same from the part of the officer for which he has stated (in his verbatim) that "*applicant had submitted property statement earlier also. but due to misunderstanding applicant filled the statement incorrectly. this was applicant's first time when he is furnishing property statement. In future, applicant assure your goodself that he will furnish property statement on time and in compliance of the Hon'ble High Court.*", mentioned in his reply dated 26.08.2023.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements for the financial years 2018-19 & 2019-20 of Sri Sumit Kumar-II, Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Div.), Pratapgarh be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Neeraj Tiwari, Administrative Judge, Pratapgarh Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
