May kindly see the property statements online received from Sushri Ruchi Tiwari, Civil Judge (Senior Division), Mathura regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by her or any member of her family for the financial years 2020-21 & 2021-22 in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2020-21 & 2021-22 of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by her are given below.

(1) In the financial years 2020-22, Total income is Rs.31,48,875/- and total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment (for both the financial years) against GIS, NPS, Income Tax, car loan and PPF are Rs.13,67,054/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.17,81,821/- was therefore available with her to meet out the household expenditure of herself in both the financial years. And the balance of her savings bank account(s) is also reduced for Rs.1,98,510/- this financial year from previous year's balance.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has already submitted her property statement at the time of joining into Judicial Service which had already been seen by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Attau Rahman Masoodi, the then Administrative Judge, Ghaziabad on e-service ID no.P00054672022. And property statement of 2014-16, 2016-18 & 2018-20 has been processed on e-service ID nos. P00054682022, P00054692022 & P00054702022 respectively.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit her property statement for the financial years 2020-21 & 2021-22 in its next financial year i.e., 2022-23 upto March 2023. She has submitted movable and immovable property statements for the financial years 2020-21 & 2021-22 vide online dated 01.12.2023. As such, there is delay in submitting the same from the part of the officer, for which she *"humbly prayed that delay in sending property Statement will not be repeated in future.The delay so caused due to work load and illness of my father"*, mentioned in remark column of movable proforma.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements for the financial years 2020-21 & 2021-22 of Sushri Ruchi Tiwari, Civil Judge (Senior Division), Mathura be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rajnish Kumar, Administrative Judge, Mathura Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
