Annual remarks recorded by the Administrative Judge/Reviewing and Accepting Authority

Ramesh Sinha(HON'BLE JUDGE)

The Officer has remained posted as Additional District & Sessions Judge/FTC, Bulandshahar during the period under assessment.

The District Judge has reported that he has achieved 1215.34 units, which are adequate. The District Judge has also reported that he has decided 51 cases after full contest, 1 execution case, 1 case on compromise and 8 cases in Lok Adalat. On criminal side, the Officer has decided 2 cases of 2012, 1 case of 2014, 3 cases of 2015 and 5 cases of 2016. On civil side, the Officer has decided 1 case of 2001, 2 cases of 2006, 1 case of 2007, 1 case of 2009, 1 case of 2010, 5 cases of 2011, 1 case of 2012, 1 case of 2013, 1 case of 2014, 2 cases of 2015 and 1 case of 2016. The District Judge has reported that the Judgments written by the Officer are sound, well-reasoned and expressed in good language.
