Annual remarks recorded by the Administrative Judge/Reviewing and Accepting Authority

Ramesh Sinha(HON'BLE JUDGE)

The Officer has remained posted as Special Judge, Anti-Corruption, C.B.I. Ghaziabad during the period under assessment.

The District Judge has reported that he has achieved 1003.48 units against the target of 1000 units, which is adequate. The District Judge has further reported that the Officer has decided 5 criminal cases after full contest and 3 old criminal cases. The District Judge has reported that the Judgments written by the Officer are sound, well-reasoned and expressed in good language. It has also been reported by the District Judge that he has properly fixed cause list and has avoided unnecessary adjournments.

The District Judge has reported that he is punctual, cool minded and impartial officer. The officer made regular inspections of his Court. His relations with the members of Bar are cordial and enjoys good relation with colleagues. His behaviour towards women is good. He is amenable to the advice of District Judge and other superior officers. Nothing adverse has been reported against him by the District Judge.


However, against column No.01 (e) (vii) [Performance with regard to decision of Motor Accident Claims related to death/injury] and column No. 01 (g) (iii) [number of cases decided on compromises/ alternate dispute resolution], the District Judge has remarked as 'nil'. In this regard, the officer has preferred a representation stating that as no case of Motor Accident Claim Petition was pending in his Court, on the date of recording of remarks, it ought to have been mentioned as 'not applicable', instead nil'. In respect of remarks mentioned against column No.01 (g)(iii), it is stated that even a single case was ever transferred to his Court nor was pending.

Considering all aspects of the matter, I find substance in the reply given by the officer concerned. Accordingly, the remarks mentioned against column Nos.01 (e) (vii) and 01 (g) (iii), shall be read as 'not applicable'.
