Act), Ghaziabad has submitted a representation dated 17-09-2021 on e-Services module against the adverse remarks occurring in col. nos. 01(a), 01(b), 01(d), 01(e)(i)(a), 01(e)(i)(b), 01(e)(ii), 01(f), 01(f)(iii), 01(f)(iii), 01(h), 01(h), 01(m) in the Annual Confidential Remarks recorded by the District & Sessions Judge, Sultanpur for the year 2020-21 as well as to upgrade his overall assessment of merit.  The submissions made by the officer in the aforesaid representation are self-explanatory. In the end, the officer has requested that his representation may kindly be placed before the Hon'ble Court for expunging the adverse remarks as well as to upgrade his overall assessment of merit.  Self assessment form submitted by the aforesaid officer alongwith his annual confidential remarks recorded by the District & Sessions Judge, Sultanpur has been forwarded/submitted by Confidential 'C' Section to Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rakesh Srivastava the then Administrative Judge, Sultanpur, for recording Court remarks in respect of the officer for the year 2020-21. Rakesh Srivastava(HON'BLE JUDGE)	Perused the representation and assessment made by the District Judge carefully. The District Judge has assessed the performance of the officer as poor. A careful perusal of the record shows that there is no material pointing out anything against the integrity of the officer. Reference to the case of Sanjay Agrahari is of no use as the said case was decided on 14.5.2019. In the said year the integrity was certified by the Court. Nothin seems to have been done by the Court on the complaint made against the officer in the above case. No other material has been pointed out or referred regarding the integrity of the officer. The comments made by the District Judge are not borne out from the record No complaint has been made by any member of the Bar regarding the integrity of the officer. For Corona period certain guidelines were issued by the Court to be observed to the officers of the district judiciary. Taking over all circumstances into consideration, I are of the view that the representation deserves to be allowed. Adverse remarks made by the District Judge are expunged. The officer is rated as good officer. Integrity certified.
