The officer remained posted as Additional District Judge/Spl. Judge POCSO-1 from 01.04.2022 to 04.07.2022, as Additional District Judge/Spl. Judge E.C.Act from 06.07.2022 to 30.11.2022, as Additional District Judge/Spl. Judge D.A.A. Act from 01.12.2022 to 02.12.2022, as Additional District Judge/Spl. Judge Sc./St. Act from 03.12.2022 to 28.03.2023 and as Additional District Judge/Spl. Judge D.A.A. Act from 29.03.2023 to 31.03.2023, during the year 2022-2023.

Perused the Self Assessment submitted by the officer. It shows that against the target of 662.50 units, the officer has achieved 1956.19 Units, which is more than adequate. The officer is fair and impartial in dealing with the Public and Bar. His relations with members of Bar and the brother/ sister officer were cordial.
