Judge Sc./St. Act from 03.12.2022 to 28.03.2023 and as Additional District Judge/Spl. Judge D.A.A. Act from 29.03.2023 to 31.03.2023, during the year 2022-2023.

Perused the Self Assessment submitted by the officer. It shows that against the target of 662.50 units, the officer has achieved 1956.19 Units, which is more than adequate.
