Annual remarks recorded by the Administrative Judge/Reviewing and Accepting Authority Rajesh Singh Chauhan (HON'BLE JUDGE) The officer remained posted as Secretary (Full Time), D.L.S.A. from 01.04.22 to 04.07.2022, Meerut, as Civil Judge (S.D.) Banda from 05.07.2022 to 21.01.2023 and as Additional Sessions Judge/F.T.C. II, Banda from 22.01.2023 to 31.03.2023, during the year 2022-2023. Perused the Self Assessment submitted by the officer. It shows that against the target of 432.96 Unit, the officer has achieved 1231.44 Units, which is more than adequate.

The officer is fair and impartial in dealing with the Public and Bar. Her relations with members of Bar and the brother/ sister officer were cordial. She made regular inspections of her court and offices in her charge. She was punctual and regular in sitting on dais in court during court hours. She had proper control over her office and has a good administrative capacity and tact.

The officer took interest in disposal of old cases and has decided adequate number of cases which are more than five years old as well as ten years old. She has also decided 16 cases wherein the litigants are more than 65 years old. Perusal of the judgments attached with the Self Assessment indicates that the same are well discussed as well as well reasoned on facts and law. No complaint against him has come to my knowledge regarding his work, conduct or integrity. She was amenable to the advice of the District Judge and other Superior Officers.
