- That I, worked as Special Judge SC/ST Act Pratapgrh in this assessment year from 01.04.2022 to 04.07.2022.
- 2. That target of, 40 cases were proposed in action plan 2022 -23 out of which 06 cases of SC/ST Court were disposed off in 1st. Quarter by me.
- 3. Then after that i took charge as Special Judge EC Act from 05.07.2022 till the end of assessment year 2022-23. In this court in 1st Quarter of assessment year by the then PO Sri. Sitaram fixed 25 Session trial (Including Special Trial + Session Trial + 10 Cri. Appeal + 10 Civil Appeal) from which 24 Session Trial + 3 Civil Appeal + 2 Cri. Appeal were decided by the then PO Sri. Sitaram in the 1st Quarter of the assessment year 2022-23.
- No Execution cases were pending in this court during the assessment year.
- 5. As when I took charge of the Special Judge EC Act Court on 05.07.2022 targeted case of Session Trial that was in number 24 cases in which 15 cases of targeted action plan of session trial were disposed by the then PO Sri. Sitaram and rest 9 Cases of session Trial of IPC was transfered from this court to Addi. District & Session Judge Court NO. 04 where Sri. - 6. Then PO Sri. Sitaram disposed of 2 Cri. Appeal + 3 Civil Appeal till the date 04.07.2022 untill he was transfered.
- 7. Remaining 8 Cri. Appeal + 5 Civil Appeal were disposed by me among targeted action plan in the assessment year 2022-23.
- Remaining 2 Civil Appeal which was not matured during the assessment year 2022-23 inspite



# Annual remarks recorded by the Administrative Judge/Reviewing and Accepting Authority

Ajay Bhanot( HON'BLE JUDGE )

I have considered the representation of the officer and the remarks in the ACR. I have been observing the performance of the officer throughout my tenure as an Administrative Judge. I find the remarks contradictory on many occasions. Further, the remarks are not justified from any material in the record and do not reflect an accurate assessment of the officer. Most importantly throughout my tenure in the Judgeship, no such shortcomings were brought to my notice at any stage by the learned District Judge. Hence, no opportunity could be given to the officer to improve her performance or to keep her under observation. I have found the officer professionally competent and her integrity is above board. I have seen the judgments rendered by the officer they are well reasoned and depict good command of law and sense of justice. Her relations with the Bar, colleagues in the Judgeship and the staff were excellent. She showed full regard to men and other vulnerable sections of the society in her dealings.

The adverse remarks are expunged in their entirety. The performance of the officer is liable to be upgraded and is upgraded as "Very Good".
