Perused the Annual remarks recorded by the then District Judge, Gorakhpur in respect of the officer for the year 2022-23 alongwith the self-assessment form of the officer.

As per Annual remarks recorded by the District Judge, Gorakhpur, disposal of the officer is 1532.81 units, out of actual target 1200 units, thus, I find it was adequate.
