I have examined the records and the report of the District Judge, Sant Kabir Nagar. The District Judge has reported one adverse remark qua the officer mentioned at column no. 1 (m) of the Annual Confidential Remark. Against the said adverse remarks, this officer has also made his representation, which has been allowed by me vide order passed today itself. The District judge has rated him as "Good" officer.

I have heard nothing against this officer nor have I received any complaint against her. The officer has given a disposal of 185.12%.
