**Annual remarks recorded by the Administrative Judge/Reviewing and Accepting Authority**

Shiv Shanker Prasad (HON'BLE JUDGE )

I have examined the records and the report of the District Judge, Sant Kabir Nagar. The District Judge has reported one adverse remark qua the officer mentioned at column no. 1 (m) of the Annual Confidential Remark. Against the said adverse remarks, this officer has also made his representation, which has been allowed by me vide order passed today itself. The District judge has rated him as "Good" officer.

I have heard nothing against this officer nor have I received any complaint against him. The officer has given a disposal of 238.22%. The total number of old cases decided by the officer is 226 and 23 criminal and 42 civil cases have been decided by this officer after full contest. 13 cases have been decided by this officer on compromise/alternate dispute resolution. This officer has also decided 66 execution cases.

On the overall assessment, I do not agree with the rating given by the District Judge to this officer and rate him as an "Outstanding" officer.
