Vivek Varma (HON'BLE JUDGE)

Perused the self assessment form submitted by the officer, remarks given by the District Judge, Barabanki and also the representation dated 10.10.2023 made by the Officer against the remarks given by the District Judge in Column I(e)(iii).

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The out-turn of the officer is adequate. He is having cordial relation with the members of the Bar and his colleagues.

The District Judge has rated the officer as 'Outstanding'. However, in his remarks at Column 1(e)(iii) the District Judge has recorded that no critically old cases pre 2000 were decided and nature of disposal (contested/otherwise) is not mentioned in the list of cases decided under Action Plan.

Against the said remarks, the officer has asserted that there were total 3 cases pre 2000 (one session trial and two civil appeals) pending in his Court and original records of the said cases were summoned by the High Court, therefore, the said cases could not be decided under the action plan. The officer has also annexed a list of nature of disposal (contested/ otherwise) of cases decided under the action plan.

The explanation given by the officer is found sufficient. Hence, the remarks made by the District Judge in Column 1(e)(iii) are modified in the light of the explanation furnished by the officer. Accordingly, the representation stands disposed of.
