Respected Sir,

It is humbly requested that through D.O. No 45/2020 dated 20.10.2020 communicated to me through the Learned District & Sessions Judge Saharanpur, in which I have received the Annual Confidential Remarks for the year of 2019-2020 recorded by the then Learned District & Sessions Judge Saharanpur.

The then Learned District & Sessions Judge, Saharanpur recorded some adverse remarks against me on following columns and on that basis given me grade 'Average'.

On the above mentioned subject respectfully I beg to submit my representation on following grounds-

(1) Column no 1(k) & Column no 4-

Column no 1(k)-

Whether the officer has made regular inspections of his court and offices in his charge and whether such inspections were full and effective?

Remarks by The District & Sessions Judge-

"Yes, (3 inspectios court and office) Total 3, officer has not reported to have made inspection for the quarter ending 30-06-2019"

Column no 4- Other remarks, if any?

Remarks by The District & Sessions Judge- *"The officer has not reported to have made quarterly inspection for the quarter ending 30.06.2019."*

With due respect regarding remarks in **Column no 1(k) & Column no 4**, It is most humbly submitted that I was in **J.T.R.I. Foundation Training Programme, Lucknow (From 01.05.2019 To 31.07.2019)**. In that circumstances It was **not possible** for me to inspect Court & Office in the **quarter end of 30.06.2019**. The same was mentioned by me in the **column no 05 of Self Assesment Form Part-II. (J.T.R.I. Foundation Training Certificate Copy Attached as Enclosure no-1)**

2. Column no 1(g) & Column no 4-

Remarks by The District & Sessions Judge-

"93.14%"

Column no 4- Other remarks, if any?

Remarks by The District & Sessions Judge- *"The officer has not been able to achieve the standard target of work and his percentage of work done is 93.14% which is below the desired target."*

With due respect regarding remarks in **column no 1 (g) & column no 4**. It is most humbly submitted that the quantum of target to be achieved by a Judicial Officer in a year has been fixed as 1200 Units. My actual work done was 1117.78 Units **'without calculating'** Foundation training, Leave, Holiday etc. **(190 Days X 3.28 Units=623.20 Units)** in my work done. I didn't calculate that **623.20 Units in work done** and **subtract** them from my **target 1200 Units**. The same was mentioned by me in column no 16 of Self Assessment Part-I :-

Target unit 1200-623.20 = 576.80 Units
Achieved Unit = 1117.78 Units.

Though, for kind persual I am most humbly submitted the calculation of Units again **after adding** the units of foundation training, leave, holiday etc-

It is therefore most humbly submitted that by the above mentioned calculation, I have achieved the target of work done and the total unit achieved by me as per calculation is **1740.98** against the 'Standard target' of **1200 Units**. In this manner **my percentage of work done is 145.08%** which is above the desired target.

It is therefore, requested that Hon'ble court be pleased to kindly reconsider sympathetically the above mentioned remarks of the then Learned District & Sessions Judge Saharanpur in the light of my explanation.

I respectfully beg to state that-

1. **My work done percentage is 145.08%** and,

2. I was in **JTRI Foundation Training Lucknow for Newly appointed Civil Judge (J.D.) (From 01.05.2019 To 31.07.2019)**, In that circumstances it was not possible for me to inspect Court and Office in the **quarter end of 30.06.2019**.


