Regarding work done by Shri Anil Kumar Verma District and Sessions Judge, Auraiya, he shows to achieve 1449.60 units, during the year, against required units 770.32 i.e. 188.18% of the required units which is quite good. The working of the officer on the administrative side is also upto the mark. The relationship with the member of bar is quite good. Though during my tenure a complaint by advocate Manjul Mishra against the ill behaviour and biased attitude of Shri Anil Kumar Verma, District and Sessions Judge, Auraiya, was received but later on this complaint was withdrawn by him. A complaint by Smt. Rajani Singh Principal Judge, Family Court, Auraiya dated 19.01.2023 was also received against Shri Anil Kumar Verma District and Sessions Judge, Auraiya regarding the payment of the bills of the vehicle provided to Principal Judge, Family Court, Auraiya for the month of September and October 2022, when the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Auraiya was vacant. A report was sought from District Judge Auraiya in this regard. During his tenure no major problem was there in the district. He has proper control over the subordinate staff. He has made regular inspections of his court, office, departments/sections under his charge. I rate overall assessment of the merit of the officer as 'GOOD'. The integrity of the officer is however certified.
