

**Joint Registrar (J) (Budget)**

May kindly see the online application of Sri Ajay Srivastava, Additional District and Sessions Judge, Ghazipur regarding grant of permission to visit UAE during winter vacation in December 2020.

In his letter, Sri Srivastava has stated that he wants to travel abroad (UAE) during winter vacation for a period of 5 days, the estimated cost of the journey will be around 1.8 lakhs (Rs. one lakh eighty thousand ) which will be bore by him from his salaried account. Photocopy of his passport, official id and bank statement of his salaried account is attached along with his application form for kind perusal. He has further stated that by his abroad visit, no dilemma is likely to create before the government of India or government of Uttar Pradesh. He had applied manually in month of October 2018 for permission to visit abroad during winter vacation of the year 2018 but no communication has been received till date about the same (neither of grant of permission nor of denial of permission). He has, therefore, requested to the Hon'ble Court for grant of permission to visit UAE in winter vacation December 2020 for the duration of 05 days.

He has also made the following declarations of his visit, which are as follows:-

1. That by his abroad visit, no dilemma is likely to create before the Government of India or before the Government of Uttar Pradesh.
2. That such type of request for abroad visit was not refused to him earlier.
3. That he has not visited any foreign country earlier.

He has, therefore, requested for grant of permission to visit UAE during winter vacation in December 2020.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per reports, no departmental/ vigilance enquiry is pending against Sri Ajay Srivastava. Permission to visit foreign country is considered vide G.O

no. 1/3/98/-Ka Prasko./1999 dated 14.06.1999 and this Court's Circular letter no. 16/ IVf-101/Admin (A) dated 27.05.2017. As per the G.O. and relevant C.L. of the Court, the officer has furnished details of his UAE visit. It is pertinent to mention here that as the officer has stated that his visit falls during winter vacation i.e. in the month of December 2020, seeing the Court's C.L. dated 27.05.2017, approving guidelines that abroad tour by any officer shall not be availed during working days of the Court or during the period of suspension/departmental proceedings, except in case of medical treatment of himself/herself, spouse or dependent, or in special circumstances and tours which are sponsored and/or approved by the State/Central Government during certain fixed span of time and does not fall during vacations. In these eventualities the Judicial Officers shall seek permission before applying for VISA. As the tour of the officer appears to be a personal trip and also falls during winter vacation in the month of December 2020, if His Lordship deem fit and proper, his request may be considered. It has been provided that for the purpose of grant of such permission the competent authority for the judicial officers is Hon'ble the Administrative Judge of the District concerned, for the Judicial officers posted in judgeship or on the District of any deputation post, subject to approval by Hon'ble the Chief Justice or any member of the Administrative Committee authorized by Hon'ble the Chief Justice. Recently vide order dated 19.10.2020, Hon'ble The Chief Justice has recently nominated Hon'ble Mr. Justice Pritinker Diwaker for the purpose.

May, therefore, if approved, the instant matter may be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Om Prakash VII, Administrative Judge, Ghazipur Judgeship for kind perusal and orders and if His Lordship approves:-

(a) Sri Ajay Srivastava, Additional District and Sessions Judge, Ghazipur may be granted permission, to visit UAE during winter

vacations 2020 for 5 days, as requested, subject to approval by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Pritinker Diwaker, Nominated Judge for the purpose as per Court's C.L. dated 27.05.2017 and as per recent order dated 19.10.2020 regarding nomination of Hon'ble Mr. Justice Pritinker Diwaker, as mentioned above, with the condition that proper charge of Government records or cash, if any, or any government property with him, may be handed over by him before proceeding abroad?
