May Kindly see the online application, of Sri Manish Arora, Addl. The officer further stated that he is a native of Chandigarh and his family lives there, his wife is working there and his daughter is studying there, that is why they cannot come to Uttar Pradesh to live with him. He has, therefore, requested the Court to permit him to apply for and to appear in the aforesaid examination.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has joined U.P. Judicial Services on 16.12.2019. Now, It is desirable that he may be accorded permission to apply for and to appear in the Preliminary Examination of Haryana Civil Services (Judicial Branch) Examination- 2020-21 for the post of Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), to be conducted by Haryana Public Service Commission, if the Court so desires. Permission to appear in such type of written examination may be accorded, but subject to the following conditions:-

1. Government work should not suffer in any way.
2. No preferential treatment will be given in the matter of leave, postings and transfer.
3. The permission can be withdrawn without notice if; it is found at any time that the government servant neglects his normal work or that public work suffers, in any way.

May, therefore, if approved by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Mahesh Chandra Tripathi, Administrative Judge, Mathura Judgeship, permission be accorded to Sri Manish Arora, Addl. Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Mathura to apply for and to appear in the Preliminary Examination of Haryana Civil Services (Judicial Branch) Examination-2020-21 for the post of Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), to be conducted by Haryana Public Service Commission, as requested, subject to the conditions mentioned above?
