May kindly see the online application of Sri Pradeep Kumar-V, Spl. J (SC/ST, Pev. Of Atroci. Act), Mainpuri regarding grant of permission to write and publish articles on the Legal topic in Newspapers, Legal Magazines, Law Papers, Seminars and Souvenirs.

In his application, Sri Pradeep Kumar has stated that he intends to write and publish articles on the Legal topic in Newspapers, Legal Magazines, Law Papers, Seminars and Souvenirs and it will be only for academic purposes as the same is one of the required column in Self Assessment. Therefore, the officer has requested for grant of permission for the same.

It is further submitted that as per Rule-6 of U.P. Government Servant's conduct Rule-1956:-

- (1) No government servant shall except with the previous sanction of the Government, own wholly or in part, or conduct or participate in editing or managing of, any newspaper or other periodical publication.
- (2) No government servant shall, except with the previous sanction of the Government or any other authority empowered by it in this behalf, or in the bona fide discharge of his duties, participate in a radio broadcast or contribute any article or write any letter, either anonymously or in his own name or in the name of any other person, to any newspaper or periodical;

Provided that no such sanction shall be required if such broadcast or such, contribution is of a purely literary, artistic or scientific character.

It is submitted that the case seems to be a considerable case as per above mentioned rule. However, acceptance of the request of the officer for grant of permission is on discretion of the Court.

May, therefore, if approved, the file be laid before Hon'ble The Chief Justice for kind perusal of His Lordship and approval that :-

1. Sri Pradeep Kumar-V, Spl. J (SC/ST, Pev. Of Atroci. Act), Mainpuri be granted permission to write and publish articles on the Legal topic in Newspapers, Legal Magazines, Law Papers, Seminars and Souvenirs, for academic purposes only, as requested?

or

2. to pass any order which His Lordship like to pass.
