
Respected Sir;

(J) That there is no possibility of arising embarrassing position before Government of U.P. due to my visit to any foreign country;

(K) That the issue of "Identity Certificate" for obtaining a passport was never applied by the applicant earlier;

(L) That I have not visited any Foreign Country earlier.
