# Subject : Submission of necessary information in the light of O.M/G.O 3143/II-B-1968 Dated 11.10.1968 regarding permission of writing Books/ Articles and their Publication.

Respected Sir,

With due respect, it is submitted that the undersigned have applied for permission of writing Articles/Books and their publication in the reputed Jounarals and Book Publication Company respectively. In this connection a query has been made by the Hon'ble Court in the light of O.M/G.O 3143/II-B-1968 Dated 11.10.1968. The undersigned is with free consent undertake that I will strictly adhere with the O.M/G.O 3143/II-B-1968 Dated 11.10.1968. Therefore the undersigned has made undertaking for strict compliance of following conditions -

- 1. The book does not bear the imprimatur of Government.
- 2. The Author's name appears on the first page of the book without his official designation. There may however, be no objection to the official designation to be given on the dustcover where the author is introduced himself to the public.
- **3.** The Author give a statement under his name on the first page of the book or at any other suitable palce that the author's views and comments in the book are entirely the responsibility of the author and Government are in no way concerned with the publication of the book.
- 4. The author should also ensure that the book does not contain any statement of fact or opinion which has any adverse critisim of any current or recent policy or action of the State Government or

Central Government or Government of any other state or local Authority.

**5.** Government servant can be permitted to accept royality both in lump sum or on a continuing basis of the Sale proceeds of the book written by them provided that if-

(a). (i). the book is written solely with the aid of the knowledge acquired in the course of service; or

(ii). The book is a mere compilation of Government rules regulations or procedures.

The author [Government Servant] should be required, unless the Governor by special order otherwise directs, to credit to the general revenues one-third of the income if it is in exceeds of Rs. 250/ or if the income is recurring one, it is in exceeds of Rs. 250/ per annum.

**(b). (i).** the book is written with the aid of knowledge acquired by the Government servant in the course of his/her service but it is not mere compilation of Government rules, regulations or procedures but reveals the author's scholarly study of the subjects; or

(ii). The work neither has nor is likely to mere any connection with the author's official position;

No part of the income recurring or non-recurring derived by him from the sale proceeds or royalties of the book need be credited to the general revenues.

In the compliance of the Hon'ble High Court's query, the above necessary information, in the light of O.M/G.O 3143/II-B-1968 Dated 11.10.1968 and Rule 15 of the Utter Pradesh Government Servant Conduct Rules, 1956, is being submitted for the kind perusal of the Hon'ble High Court.
