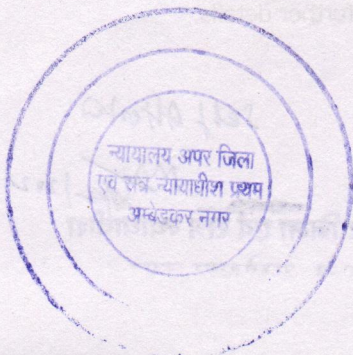

Visa information

The University will begin the CAS issuance process once you have paid the £3,000 pre-registration deposit, or have provided proof of sufficient financial sponsorship. 

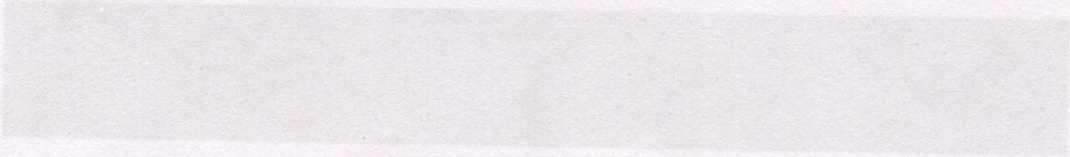
