Sir/Madam,

I am directed to intimate that the Examination for promotion to the post of Inspector Posts for the year 2013 was held from 14th & 15th September, 2013 in 19 circles except in Gujarat, Haryana & Kerala circle. The Competent Authority has ordered for declaring the result of the above examination for 19 Circles and accordingly the result is hereby declared.

2. After holding the Examination on 14/15-9-2013, the Competent Authority ordered for displaying the provisional keys for all Papers in the departmental website inviting comments/feedback from participants within 15 days from the date of publication. Accordingly, the provisional keys for four papers were displayed in the Indiapost website on 26/10/2013. 78 representations were received.. The feedback received from the 78 participants were examined in detail.

3. After detailed examination of the issues, the Competent Authority ordered to revise the provisional keys in respect of following questions:

5. This Examination was held as per the revised Syllabus and Pattern Communicated by SPB.II section in letter No.7-14/2011-SPB.II dt. 9-3-2011

6. The Names of candidates declared successful for promotion as Inspector Posts in each Circle except in Gujarat, Haryana and Kerala Circles, with Vacancy position is furnished in Annexure.

6. The Eligibility criteria for qualifying/selection as provided for in the letter No. 7-14/2011-SPB.II dt. 9-3-2011 is as under:-

For General Candidates	40% marks in each Paper subject to an overall average of 45%
For SC/ST candidates	33% marks in each Paper subject to an overall average of 38%

Due to deletion of one Question in each paper, the maximum marks is restricted to 298 marks in each paper and eligibility criteria prescribed is as under:

Category	Qualifying marks in each Paper	Aggregate marks
OC candidates	119 marks out of 298 marks in each Paper (40%)	536 aggregate marks out of 1192 total marks (45%)
SC/ST	98 marks out of 298 marks in each Paper (33%)	453 aggregate marks out of 1192 total marks (38%)

7. The Information relating to the Names of the Candidates, their OMR Applications No. Roll numbers and categories have been shown on the basis of information furnished by the concerned Circles. The Circles are requested for verifying the details before communicating the results and in case any discrepancy in the names and other particulars of the candidate(s) is noticed/found later on, the same may please be corrected and the corrections may be brought to the notice of this office for making necessary incorporation in the records.

8. In case, subsequently if it is found that any of the selected candidate(s) was not eligible to take the examination under the extant rules or instructions on the subject for any other reasons or in case any mistake is found with regard to announcement of the result of any candidate for any reason whatsoever, his/her name will be deleted from the list of successful candidates, as the case may be.

9. Consequent on issue of revised Recruitment Rules for Inspector Posts 2013, issued on 1-2-2013 the special concessions applicable for APS Personnel as provided in DG P&T letter No. 7/29/65-SPB-II dated 7th June, 1965 and as per Para (3)© & 9 (b) of Rule 279/1 of P&T Manual, Volume IV, sub rule 85 under Chapter V of Appendix A of P&T Man. Vol IV part II, stand superseded vide Directorate letter no. 7-14/2009-SPB-II dated 5-9-2013, Therefore the candidates working on deputation to APS; who have come in the zone of merit on their own were selected to the extent of notified vacancies in respective circles.

10. Review of failed SC/ST candidates:- The Circles where there are SC/ST vacancies remained unfilled, will immediately take up the process of Review of failed SC/ST candidates so that vacancies left unfilled can be filled up through the review and this process should be completed within a period of three months and proposal of High Power Committee are submitted to the SPB II Section for approval of the Competent Authority.

11. Provisional Candidates: The Heads of the concerned Circles are requested to immediately finalize the cases and such cases should not be kept pending for long time so that the provisional candidates may not have to wait for the result inordinately. It may also be ensured that no provisional candidate is given appointment under any circumstances without regularization of their candidature and approval of the Directorate.

12. It is informed that the names of the candidates have been arranged in the order of merit. *In respect of candidates who got equal marks in the total, Circles are requested to arrange their position in the merit list according to their inter se seniority/instructions on the subject and intimate the same to DE/SPN Sections of the Directorate.*

13. Applications under RTI Act for supply of photocopies of OMR Answer Sheets will be entertained in the following manner:


- (a) Candidates, who wish to have the copies of OMR Answer Sheets supplied, are required to pay a fee of Rs.25/- per Paper with Key + Rs.10- towards fee for application under RTI Act in the Post Office accounts and submit their applications through their respective Circle Offices concerned along with the receipt for payment of fee in original. Circle Office will prepare a consolidated list and send to the Directorate for necessary supply. The individual applications received direct for supply of answer scripts will not be entertained.
- (b) A copy of this letter with enclosures has been uploaded on www.indiapost.gov.in. Requests for supply of this document under RTI Act will not be entertained.
- (c) The period of preservation of OMR Answer Sheets is one year from the date of declaration of this result. Therefore, applications received after one year for supply of photocopies of OMR Answer Sheets will not be entertained.

- (d) Photocopies of OMR Answer Sheets will be supplied to the candidates only those who have actually appeared in the Examination. Therefore, the candidates should invariably intimate their Roll Number in the Application made under RTI.
- (e) Request for supply of all India marks list under RTI Act will not be entertained as it will be uploaded in India Post website in public domain and can be accessed by individuals. All the candidates may be informed accordingly.
- (f) The final key for the Question Papers I to IV will also be uploaded on www.indiapost.gov.in, requests for supply of this key document under RTI Act will not be entertained.
- (g) The marks of the provisionally permitted candidates for different reasons will not be displayed in the All India Master List and the marks of those candidates cannot be communicated until and unless their provisional candidature is regularized by the respective Circles. This may be made clear to all the concerned.
- 15 The Heads of Circles are requested for circulating this result to all the concerned and also to take necessary action for their Pre Induction Training and other formalities before the selected candidates are appointed as Inspector Posts.
