ABOUT BIKANER

Bikaner is a city in the northwest of the state of Rajasthan in northern India. It is located 330 kilometres (205 mi) northwest of the state capital, Jaipur. Bikaner city is the administrative headquarters of Bikaner District and Bikaner division. It was formerly the capital of the princely state of Bikaner. The city was founded by Rajput Rao Bika in 1486 and from its small origins it has developed into the fifth largest city in Rajasthan. The Ganges Canal, completed in 1928, and the Indira Gandhi Canal, completed in 1987, facilitated its development.


Climate

Bikaner is situated in the middle of the Thar desert and has a hot climate with very little rainfall and extreme temperatures. The climate in Bikaner is characterised by significant variations in temperature. In the summer season it is very hot when the temperatures lie in the range of 28-48.5 °C. In the winter, it is fairly cold with temperatures lying in the range of 5-23.2 °C. Annual rainfall is in the range of 260-440 millimetres.

Art and culture


Bikaner is notable for Asia's biggest National Research Centre for Camel (NRCC), handicrafts and leather articles, Bikaneri bhujia, Karni Mata temple, wool production, camel festival, havelies and palaces, sweets, PATA culture (wooden made big square size table which is placed in the streets where localites sit at their leisure) and its warm hearted people. The city is also known for its intricately carved Jharokas. These red sandstone jalis (screens) are found on the windows of the Junagarh fort, temples and havelies (mansions of Northern India). The red sandstone for these stone window screens was supplied by the nearby village of Dulmera.



Jurisdiction

Notwithstanding anything contained in any law for the time being in force but subject to the provisions of the University of Rajasthan Act, 1946, the Rajasthan Agriculture University, Bikaner Act, 1987 (Act No. 39 of 1987), the Rajasthan Sanskrit University Act, 1998 (Act No. 10 of 1998), the Maharana Pratap University of



Agriculture and Technology Udaipur Act, 2002 (Act No. 8 of 2000) and the Rajasthan Ayurved University Act, 2002 (Act No.15 of 2002) the jurisdiction of the University extends to all the constituent, affiliated or autonomous colleges, institutes and departments within the Bikaner Division of the State of Rajasthan as notified by the State Government under the provisions of the Rajasthan Land Revenue Act, 1956 (Act No. 15 of 1956) and also to such other constituent, affiliated or autonomous colleges, institutes and departments within the State of Rajasthan as may be specified by notification in the Official Gazette by the State Government.

- To develop a logical mindset to enable the students to thrive in the world of competition by judicious balance between ethichal and career oriented education.


Objectives

- Facilitating programmes aiming at capacity building for leadership and social service.





COURSES OFFERED AT UNIVERSITY CAMPUS

The University has created five academic Departments (Environmental Science, Microbiology, Computer Science, English and History) in its campus and academic activities have been started from the academic session-2011-12. At the core of our wide range of academic inquiry is the commitment to attract and engage the best minds in pursuit of greater human understanding, pioneering new discoveries, and service to society. Our distinguished faculty, alumni, and student are excelling in the field of science, arts, humanities and other professions. The University offers an outstanding and comprehensive array of academic programs. The Semester system has been successfully introduced in all the five departments of University from the session 2014-15.



DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

The University took lead in establishing the Department of Environmental Science, which is the first such Department in whole of the Western

Rajasthan. The Department offers Post Graduate education (M.Sc. Environmental Science) in this highly professional and job oriented discipline. Besides research degrees of M.Phil. and Ph.D., the Department offers consultancy for Environmental Impact Assessment, air, water and soil quality management, pollution abatement, planning and monitoring wildlife conservation.

A permanent Global Positioning Station (GPS) in collaboration with ML Sukhadia University, Udaipur has been developed and has started collecting meteorological and seismological data through satellite. This is a part of National Network of GPS receivers that collect data from the satellites which can be used for the study of crustal movements, atmospheric behaviour, weather forecasting etc.



The Department has a well stocked library holding good number of reference and text books in core and allied subjects. It has a state of the art laboratory equipped with almost all required instruments and related paraphernalia. Backed by a highly professional and dedicated faculty to groom young environmental

In the Department two major projects are running, funded by CAIRN India Ltd. & National Remote Sensing Centre (NRSC) Indian Space Research Organization (IJRO).






Student's Intake:

DEPARTMENT OF COMPUTER SCIENCE

The Department of Computer Science of Maharaja Ganga Singh University was established in 2011 with an objective to produce Computer Science and information technology (IT) professionals for software industries and for research and educational institutions. The Department is playing its significant role in the academic and intellectual advancement of the University by providing support of latest IT skills. The Department is offering at present master's program in Computer Science only. The course is designed to enhance the intellectual capacity of students and provide them career opportunities in future.



The Department has two well equipped state-of-art laboratories and

classrooms having proper arrangements for light and ventilation. The Department also has a UPS room, a server room, faculty room and an office. Both the laboratories are connected with a 10 KVA Online UPS for un-interrupted power supply. Other rooms of the Department are connected with the DG Set when power supply goes interrupted on power cut off. All the computers in both laboratories are connected with Ethernet LAN. Laboratories have LAN connectivity to get Internet access facility provided by 1GBPS leased line connection under NMEICT project.



ADMISSION POLICY

The University largely follows the policy and guidelines of the Government of Rajasthan in the matters relating to admission, reservation of seats and academic calendar. Admission to M.Phil. class will be made through M.Phil./Ph.D. Combined Entrance Test (MPCET). The details regarding admission in M.Phil and Ph.D. are given in the Ordiance of the University which is uploaded on University website.

GENERAL INFORMATION

ENROLLMENT

No one shall be admitted to any examination of the University unless enrolled as a student of the University. The enrollment fee shall be paid once only irrespective of the number of times the candidate appears at examination of the University or whether he/she appears as regular student or as ex-student of an affiliated college of the University or as a private candidate.

MIGRATION

In the case of student who takes a migration certificate to join another University, his membership of the university shall lapse until such time as he may subsequently return with a Migration Certificate from the other University. No enrollment in such case shall, however, be necessary. Provided that this lapse of membership shall not debar a student from appearing at an examination in an examination in an additional optional subject for a degree already taken from the University.

ATTENDANCE RULES

The expression "regular course of study" means attendance required to be put in by the candidate in the lectures, tutorials and practicals as provided in the ordinances for the respective examinations to be taken by the candidate. Subject to the provisions of condonation, a candidate who fails to put in the required minimum attendance shall not be allowed to appear at the examination.

The University would be under an obligation to ensure 75% attendance of a regular student out of the total classes held in an academic session in the University Departments/Constituent Colleges/Colleges affiliated to the University as required under the guidelines of U.G.C. and as per direction of Hon'ble High Court, Rajasthan.

In no case relaxation is given for appearing in the examination where the student has not completed 75% attendance

DISCIPLINARY ACTION

The following provisions are laid down for dealing with the cases of indiscipline:

- 1. When a student has been accused/guilty of serious criminal charge(s)/grave misconduct/persistent negligence of work or misbehaviour, the Principal of the constituent/affiliated college/Director of University School or College or Institutions/Head of University Teaching Department/Dean, University Studies in Arts/Fine Arts/Social Science/Science/Commerce/Law where he is studying, the Chief Proctor may suspend a student forthwith from attending the classes. During the period of suspension, the student will not be allowed to participate in any activity of the College/University including appearing at the examination. When the student has been suspended or an inquiry is pending against him, the Warden or the Chief Warden of University Hostel(s)/Principal may suspend or remove such a student from the hostel.
- 2. Soon after suspension, the case will be referred to the standing Discipline Committee of the College/University. The Chairman of the Standing Committee shall be a senior member of the teaching staff with 5 to 6 other members of staff nominated by the Principal/Vice-Chancellor. The members should preferably be the representatives fro all the major faculties.
- 3. If a criminal case has been registered in a court of law by the Police Station, the student shall be suspended immediately.
- 4. No student who has been so suspended or expelled shall be admitted to any other College/teaching unit of the University without the permission of the authority which suspended / expelled him within the period of his suspension/expulsion.
- 5. On appeal from the student, the Director, College Education in the case of affiliated college and the Vice-Chancellor in the case of the University teaching units

may review the case and after due consideration may decide to concur or enhance or reduce the punishment

- 6. All cases of indiscipline shall be reported to the parents/guardians of the concerned students.
- 7. If any student causes damage to University/College property in addition to the disciplinary action, the student or his parents/guardians shall have to compensate the damage caused.

PROCTORIAL SYSTEM

The University has a Proctorial system, which deals with the problems connected with the maintenance of discipline on the University campus. A strict and immediate action may be taken against any student who violates discipline. All cases of indiscipline are reported to the parents of the defaulters. The parents of defaulters are also invited to discuss the cases of their wards, if any student is found guilty more than once or whenever the Proctor considers it necessary. This proctorial officer also maintains a Defaulters Register in which the record of all cases of indiscipline is kept.

Under ordinance 88 the following action can also be taken:

- 1. Entry of the defaulters and punishment given can be made in the Character/Transfer Certificate.
- 2. Character Certificate may be refused.
- 3. Admission in the next session may be refused.
- 4. Record of action taken or punishments given be communicated to future employers in case a confidential enquiry is received.

The University community is a family and any act of indiscipline is a loss to the whole institution. It is the moral duty of every student to safeguard the honour and fair name of his/her institution.

The College/Department issues an identity card to every student. This must always be carried by every student with him. They must produce this card for identification whenever required by the authorities. Action may be taken against students who fail to produce their identity card when required by the Proctor/any other authorized officer of the University in buses, libraries or any other place of academic activities.

In case of indiscipline or breach of peace, the aggrieved party will report to the Proctor/Head of the Department concerned who will investigate and take disciplinary action. A copy of the report and action taken shall be sent to the office of the Chief Proctor for the purpose of record. The cases of indiscipline involving students of more than one Department will be dealt with by the Chief Proctor to whom the aggrieved party will send his complaint through the Proctor/Head of the Department.

The Central Library of the University was shifted to its sprawling and state of art building located in University campus in 2013. Library Sections


The Central Library has following sections:

I. ACQUISITION SECTION

In order to acquire all sorts of reading and research materials, there is an Acquisition Section which acquires and collects them for the use of the readers. In order to provide these reading materials, the acquisition section after accessioning the reading materials sends them to the technical section for processing so that books and other reading materials could be used in their respective sections.

II. TECHNICAL SECTION

There is a Technical Section for the processing of all reading and research materials acquired, where they are classified and catalogued and labeled and pasted before they are sent to the respective sections.



III. CIRCULATION SECTION

The Students and the Faculty mambers can borrow and return books through this section. At present, there are more than 5000 books for circulation.

IV. PERIODICAL SECTION

There is a well-equipped section of Periodical Literature to meet the needs of the Faculty members, the research scholars and the students. In this Section all the current periodicals are displayed properly for the use of the readers and their back and bound volumes are maintained in systematic order.

V. RESEARCH AND REFERENCE SECTION

In this section, doctoral dissertations approved by this University, are maintained properly, and provided for consultation to the research scholars / teachers of affiliated Colleges and research scholars of other universities. This section also maintains other categories of reference materials required for research purpose.

VI. REPROGRAPHIC SECTION

To provide Reprographic services, there is a Photocopier section, which has an advanced photocopying machine for providing Photostat copies of the document desired.

VII. COMPUTER SECTION

At present the library subscribes DELNET facility for all its users. Through this facility users search books in union catalogue and use them by the inter library loan facility.

Since its inception, the University has paid attention to Sports and Games. Both male and female Students are given equal opportunities to demonstrate their talent in games & sports. The performance of the University players and athletes has been remarkable especially in Cycling, Weight Lifting/Power lifting, Athletics, Shooting, Archery, Judo, and Handball in Inter University Competitions.

By and large in an academic session, around 50 inter college competitions are organized by the affiliated colleges of the University and around 40 to 45 University sports team participate in inter University competition every year. 
