1- Priyambada Lal, Nyayadhikari (Gram Nyayalay, Tehsil Baraut-Baghpat) declared as under-

- (a)- That the applicant is a citizen of India.
- (b)- That the applicant may not, or in not likely to, engage outside India in activities prejudicial to the sovereignty and integrity of India.
- (c)- That the departure of the applicant from India may not, or is not likely to be detrimental to the security of India.

- (h)- That the applicant has not been repatriated.
- (i)- That there is no possibility of arising embarrassing position before government of U.P. due to my visit to any foreign country.
- (j)- That issue of "identity certificate" for obtaining a passport was never refused to me.
- (k)- That I have previously visited foreign countries, details as follows: I held the Multi-entry United Kingdom visa Tier 2 ICT short term staff migrant from 21.12.2013 to 03.05.2014 and resided in London, United Kingdom for work purposes. I held Multi-entry Schengen visa (tourist visa) from 07.01.2014 to 10.04.2014 and travelled to France, Belgium, Netherlands for tourism purposes while residing in London during the same period.
