Subject- Reply to the Objection Raised by Hon'ble Court on the application seeking permission to pursue and continue the PhD from Faculty of Law, Nehru Gram Bharti (Deemed university) Prayagaraj (Uttar Pradesh).

Respected Sir,

I, Ratn Shekhar Nirmal Civil Judge (Junior Division)/F.T.C. Fatehpur had applied for the grant of permission to complete my PhD from Faculty of Law, Nehru Gram Bharti (Deemed university) Prayagaraj, Uttar Pradesh. In reply to the objections/Clarifications sought by the Hon'ble Court, I have following submissions to make –

1. I got enrolled as a Research Scholar at Faculty of Law, Nehru Gram Bharti (Deemed to be University), Prayagraj, for my Ph.D. degree on 03.08.2017. (Admission receipt and letter of registrar Annexed herewith as **Annexure No. 01 and 02**)

2. I have **completed my Course Work for the same in April, 2018**, result of which was **declared on 02.04.2018** which is prior to my joining to the U.P. Judicial Services. (Result of course work is Annexed herewith as **Annexure No. 03** kindly peruse).

3. I have joined the Uttar Pradesh Judicial services on **15 November, 2019** in pursuance to the **Notification/Appointment No. 4062/Admin. (Services)/2019**. (Relevant Notification is Annexed herewith as **Annexure No. 04**)

4. The topic for my PhD Research is "**Judicial Reforms in India with special reference to speedy trial**". Prof (Dr.) Amit Kumar Srivastava was appointed as my research supervisor at the time of my registration in PhD. (Guide allotment letter Annexed herewith as **Annexure No. 05**)

5. I have applied for the PhD continuation and to completion permission at the Faculty of Law from Nehru Gram Bharti (Deemed to be

University) and same has been approved by the Board of Research Faculty of Law from Nehru Gram Bharti (Deemed to be University) and letter in this regards issued by respected Registrar of the University and mentioned that "He has completed his course work successfully before joining Judicial Services on 15.11.2019 as indicated in his application dated 20.10.2020 to the University. **The minimum period to complete the Ph.D. Degree is 36 months including coursework and this intails a minimum duration of 24 months as residential period at the approved centre of this University. He has joined Ph.D. Course on 03.08.2017 in the University.** His work is in progress." Therefore I have completed my residential period of 24 months before joining of my Service in Judiciary and there is no need to attend in regular classes after completion of Course work and minimum residential period i.e. 24 months. (Letter of Respected Registrar is Annexed herewith as **Annexure No. 02**)

6. The University does not require any researcher to attend class once s/he is done with the course work as mentioned in prospectus of the Nehru Gram Bharti (Deemed to be University), Prayagraj. Therefore, I have not taken any class after joining in the U.P. Judicial Services and was in touch with my supervisor through electronic means. **(Please peruse the page no. 9 of the Prospectus attached herewith, Letter of Respected Registrar and Clause 7 at page 9 & 10 of the annexed Ordinance III of University Grant commission regarding M.Phil. and Ph.D) for rules regarding the attendance of a research scholar during and after completion of course work).** (Prospectus of the Nehru Gram Bharti (Deemed to be University), Prayagraj Annexed herewith as **Annexure No. 06, Letter of Registrar as Annexure 02 and Ordinance III of U.G.C. regarding M.Phil. and Ph.D as Annexure 07)**)

7. No 'Study Leave' will be required in case the Hon'ble Court permits me to continue and pursue my research degree from the Faculty of Law from Nehru Gram Bharti (Deemed to be University) and approx 80 percent my research work and thesis was completed before joining of My service in judiciary as I have completed my residential period of 24 months and during that time I did my research work.

8. As of my research work was completed approx 80 percent and thesis was written but now my research work is on hold in anticipation of Hon'ble Court's permission.

9. The undersigned most humbly tenders an unconditional apology for the delay caused in sending this reply to the objections sought by the Hon'ble Court. The undersigned was waiting for the clearance by the Board of Research in Law Faculty of Law from Nehru Gram Bharti (Deemed to be University). And recently, the Board of Research in Law Faculty of Law from Nehru Gram Bharti (Deemed to be University) has forwarded the application of undersigned and issued letter by Respected Registrar.

Therefore, it is humbly prayed that the Hon'ble high Court of Judicature at Allahabad may kindly be pleased to permit the undersigned to


