Sir,

With reference to your endt. no. 2518/I dated 14.10.2014 on the above subject, I am directed to say that the Court has been pleased to pass the following order in the matter of grant of permission to Sri Rajat Singh Jain, Spl. J. (SC/ST, Pev.of Atroci Act), Bulandshahr, to sell his old Tata Indica Xeta car:

"Genuineness of transaction is doubtful. A sum of Rs. 1,50,000/- is said to have been received by the officer through ECS on 22.04.2013 as sale consideration of the vehicle. Transferred documents were not completed & permission is now being sought after more than one year. Reason for such delay has not been explained. It is also not clear as to when the entire amount of sale consideration was paid by purchaser; why the officer immediately did not handover the vehicle to the purchaser and why purchaser did not take possession thereof and took further action for transfer of registration in his name. Why these facts were not informed to this Court immediately at that time. In the meantime the said vehicle is said to have met with an accident, which was got repaired by the purchaser. Insurance amount has been claimed by the officer concerned. The sale consideration has also been reduced to rs. 1,20,000/- now. Let the officer explain as to why he could not inform the Court in April 2013 when he accepted Rs. 1,50,000/- from the alleged buyer."

Sri Jain may kindly be informed accordingly and asked to comply with the Court's order, referred to above.
