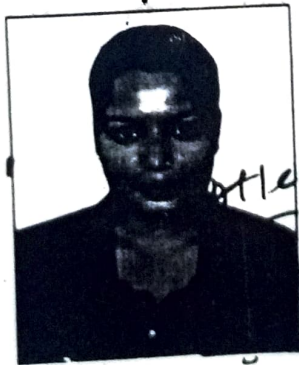


IDENTITY CERTIFICATE
