It is to intimate that a matter regarding counting of post service rendered in the State Government before joining NIA for Pension/ consequential benefits was taken up with the MHA. The MHA in consultation with DoP&PW and DoP&T has.

In accordance with DoP&PW OM dated 20.10.2009, for counting of past i) service of Central/ State Government, an employee has to fulfill these conditions:

joined previous service before 01.01.2004, b)

he should have been governed by CCS(Pension) Rules 1972, Railway Pension Rules, 1993 or other similar on-contributory pensionable establishments of Central/ State Govts covered by old Pension Rules other than CCS(Pension) C)

he had applied through proper channel and was relieved from his previous organization to take the appointment in Central Government with proper permission. Counting of past service in the State Govt. would not be permissible if any of these conditions is not fulfilled. ii)

Pay protection of State Government employees on their appointment in Central Government, subsequent to the implementation of the 7th CPC is regulated in terms of DoPT OM No. 12/2/2016.Estt(Pay-I) dated 11.05.2017. iii)

Para 2.8 of the DoPT OM dated 17.08.16 states that a Government servant covered under NPS, the balance standing to their Personal Retirement Account along with their PRAN will be carried forward to their new Department.

iv) Para 3.6.1 states that for appointment to posts under Central Government on results of a competition permanent/ provisionally permanent State Government employees will be entitled to joining time under the CCS(joining Time) Rules, 1979.

Para 3.6.3 clarified that for appointment to posts under Central V) Government on the basis of results of a competition permanent/ provisionally permanent State Government employees shall be entitled to Transfer travelling allowance.

Vi) Rule 39-D of the CCS(Leave) Rules 1972 is not applicable in respect of State Government employees joining Central Government.

Vii) Past service rendered in State Government will not be counted for the purpose of determining eligibility service for promotion to the next level post.

The proposal regarding counting of past service rendered by Shri Arjun Ambalapatta in the NIA as Public Prosecutor (PP) on deputation from 04.01/2011 to 03.07.2014 as 'regular service' for purpose of promotion to the next grade has been examined. In this regard, it is to inform that deputation is one of the modes of recruitment where officers of the Central Govt./State Govt/UT Admns. from outside are appointed to post(s) in Central Govt. for a specific period and at the end of which the officer will return to his parent cadre. The service rendered on deputation, being not a 'regular service' in the Borrowing organization/Cadre, cannot be counted as regular service for promotion to the next grade in the borrowing organization. Therefore, the request of Shri Ambalapatta, PP to count his service rendered in NIA on deputation for promotion to the Grade of Sr.PP is

The case for counting of past service of Shri Abshishek Kumar Bagaria, 3. PP rendered in the UP Govt. as Assistant Public Prosecutor for purpose of Pension/consequential benefits was examined in consultation with DoP&PW. DoP&PW has clarified as under:-

"In accordance with DoPPW O.M. dated 20.10.2009, for counting of past service of Central / State Government, an employee has to fulfill these conditions (i) joined previous service before, 01.01.2004, (ii) He should have been governed by CCS(Pension) Rules, 1972, Railway Pension Rules, 1993 or other similar on-contributory pensionable establishments of Central / State Govts. covered by old Pension Rules other than CCS(Pension) Rules, 1972, (iii) he had applied through proper channel and was relieved from his previous organization to take the appointment in Central Government with proper permission. Counting of past service in the State Govt. would not be permissible if any of these conditions is not fulfilled".

Since Shri Abshishek Kumar Bagaria, does not fulfill 1st two conditions 4. mentioned above. His request to count his service rendered in the UP Govt. is not permissible. However, DoP&PW had advised that DoPT may be consulted for counting of service for other benefits e.g. pay protection, leave/joining time etc.

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Therefore, the matter was also examined in consultation with DoPT. The 5. DoPT has clarified the matters vide their ID No. 1295694/CR/18 dated 24.04.2018(copy enclosed) as under:-

- i) Pay protection of State Government employees on their appointment Central Government, in subsequent to the implementation of the 7th CPC is regulated in terms of DoPT OM No. 12/2/2016. Estt(Pay-I) dated 11.05.2017.
- Para 2.8 of the DoPT OM dated 17.08.16 states that a Government ii) servant covered under National Pension System, the balance standing to their Personal Retirement Account alongwith their PRAN will be carried forward to their new Department.
- iii) Para 3.6.1 states that for appointment to posts under Central Government on results of a competition permanent/provisionally _permanent State Government employees will be entitled to joining time under the CCS(joining Time) Rules, 1979. iv)
- Para 3.6.3 clarifies that for appointments to posts under Central Government basis of results of a on the completion permanent/provisionally permanent State Government employees shall be entitled to Transfer travelling allowance. V)
 - Rule 39-D op the CCS(Leave) Rules, 1972 is not applicable in ✓ respect of State Government employees Government.
 - Past service rendered in State Government will not be counted for the purpose of determining eligibility service for promotion to the next level post.

In view of the above, NIA is requested to follow the instructions/guidelines 6. of DoPT/ DoP&PW in the matter and dispose of the representations of above officers accordingly.

2. The promotion shall be subject to the judgement dated 26.09.2018 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in SLP (C) No. 30621/2011.

3. They should avail their promotion within one month from the date of issue of the order. If any officer fails to avail the promotion for any reason or ground, he can forego his promotion and will not be considered for the promotion for next one year from the date of refusal and the next person in the panel will be offered the promotion. After the expiry of one year, if it is still decided to promote him, he shall be considered for the promotion only against the next vacancy becoming available to accommodate him. He will not be allowed to avail the benefit of the original seniority in the above panel, which he would have retained had he not refused promotion in turn. However, in case, reasons adduced by any official for his refusal of promotion are not acceptable to the competent authority, the promotion would be enforced on him and in case the officer still refuses to be promoted, he will be liable to face disciplinary action for refusing to obey the orders.

4. In terms of Ministry of PPG&P (DoP&T), Government of India O.M. No. 20034/5/2002-Estt(D) dated 04.08.2004, if the above-mentioned officer is found to be on a sanctioned leave, an intimation about his promotion may be sent to his

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in the higher post.

5. On promotion, the inter-se-seniority of the above mentioned officers in the grade of Senior Public Prosecutor will be in the same order as per the above panel.

6. The controlling officer may ensure that those of the afore-mentioned officials against whom any of the following conditions are fulfilled may not be allowed to take over on promotion and a report of the same may please be sent to NIA Hqrs immediately:-

i) Under suspension,

ii) A charge sheet has been issued and the disciplinary proceedings are pending,

iii) Prosecution for a criminal charge is pending.

7. The above mentioned officers, on promotion as Senior Public Prosecutor may exercise their option for fixation of their pay in terms of FR 22(I)(a)(1). The officers, who have been granted financial up-gradation under the ACP/MACP Scheme, need not exercise option under FR 22(I)(a)(1) as no pay fixation benefit shall accrue to them on promotion against a functional post of the Senior Public Prosecutor.
