- 5. I hereby declare that the book is written solely with the aid of the knowledge acquired in the course of service, but it is not a mere compilation of Government rules, regulations or procedures, but reveals the author's literary work and scholarly study of the subject.
- 6. I hereby declare that the work neither has nor is likely to have any connection with the author's official positions; no part of the income recurring or

unrecurring derived by him from the sale proceeds or royalties of the book need be credited to the general revenues.
