- 3)(a)The book is purely an academic and intellectual legal work and the same is not intended to harm anyone in his or her reputation or otherwise.
- 4)The author should also ensure that the book does not contain any statement of fact or opinion which has any adverse criticism of any current or recent policy or action of the State Government or Central Government or Government of any State or local authority.
- 5)Government servants can be permitted to accept royalty both in lumpsum or on a continuing basis on the sale proceeds of the book written by them provided that if:
- a) (i) the book is written solely with the aid of the knowledge acquired in the course of service; or
 - (ii)the book is a mere compilation of Government rules, regulations or procedures;

The author should be required, unless the Governor, by the special order, otherwise directs to credit to the general revenues one-third of the income if it is in excess of rupees 250.00 or if the income is a recurring one, it is in excess of rupees 250.00 per annum
