

Before The Registrar General, Hon'ble High Court of judicature at Allahabad.

Affidavit in the matter of:- Issuance of No Objection Certificate for obtaining Passport.

I, Krishna Swaroop Dhar Dwivedi, S/o Sri Kedar Nath Dhar Dwivedi, R/o Type IV/03, Judge's Colony, Stanley Road, Prayagraj, PIN-211001, U.P. do hereby solemnly affirm and state as follows:

1. That, the deponent is a Citizen of India.
2. That, the deponent is not likely to engage outside India in activities prejudicial to the sovereignty and integrity of India.
3. That, the departure of the deponent from India is not likely to be detrimental to the security of India.
4. That, the presence of deponent outside India is not likely to prejudice the friendly relation of India with any foreign country.
5. That, the deponent has, at any time, during the period of 5 years immediately preceding the date of his application, not being convicted by a court in India, for any offence, involving moral turpitude and sentenced in respect thereof to imprisonment for not less than 2 years. That no proceedings in respect of any offence alleged to have been committed by deponent are pending before any criminal court in India.
6. That, a warrant or summon for the appearance of the deponent or for the arrest of the deponent has not been issued by any court, under any law, for the time being in force or that any order prohibiting the departure of deponent from India, has not been made by any such court.
7. That, the deponent has not been repatriated.
8. That, the opinion of the Central Govt. the issue of a Passport or a Travel document to the deponent, will be in the public interest.
9. That, there is no possibility of arising of any embarrassing position before the Hon'ble High Court, the entire Judicial Institution, the Govt. of India, or the Govt. of U.P. due to deponent's proposed visit to foreign countries.
10. That, during such proposed foreign visit, the deponent will not indulge in any such activity that may adversely affect in the International relations of the other country with the Republic of India, or tends to tarnish the image of Hon'ble High Court, the entire Judicial Institution, the Govt. of India, or Govt. of U.P.
11. That the deponent has visited Thailand, from 02.05.2015 to 09.05.2015 in past, and it was prior to his joining the Uttar Pradesh Higher Judicial Service on 02.07.2015.
12. That, no criminal proceeding (in respect of any offence committed by the deponent) is pending before any Criminal Court in India.
13. That the dependents family members of the deponent are:

Vishesh Dhar Dwivedi (Son) 15 Years
Pannush Dhar Dwivedi (Son) 09 Years
