Subject: Submission of information against objections raised by  
Hon'ble High Court regarding 'permission to visit Nepal'

Respected Sir,

The applicant most humbly begs to submit that the applicant has applied for permission to visit Nepal on 08.02.2024.

Certain objections have been raised in this regard. My humble reply to the objections in light of Hon'ble Court's CL no. 16/IV-f-101/Admin (A)/dated 27.05.2017 is as follows:-

(1) Purpose of Visit: The applicant wishes to visit Pashupati Nath Ji Temple at Kathmandu for religious purpose and surrounding places of interest/ pilgrimage for recreational purpose.

(2) The proposed visit is planned in Holi Holidays & local holidays. The dates are 23.03.2024 to 27.03.2024. 23.03.2024 is fourth Saturday, 24.03.2024 is Sunday, 25.03.2024 is Holi Holiday and 26.04.2024 & 27.04.2024 are local holidays at District Court, Maharajganj.

(3) The applicant has not sought permission to visit abroad earlier and hence no such permission was ever denied by Hon'ble Court.

(4) The applicant further submits that the visit by applicant is not likely to create any dilemma before Government of India or Government of Uttar Pradesh.

(5) The applicant will spend on his visit from his own pocket (Salary Account), the visit is entirely personal/ not sponsored by anyone. Estimated expenditure is about rupees fifty thousand. The

account statement/copy of passbook has been submitted showing available balance.

In above facts and circumstances, it is most humbly requested that the Hon'ble High Court may be pleased to grant permission on my application for which I shall be highly obliged.
