Respected Sir,

I am Mohammad Ehtesham, a member of Delhi Higher Judicial Service, presently undergoing training at the Delhi Judicial Academy. Most respectfully in respect of the above mentioned subject I have to submit as under:

1. It is submitted that I was granted conditional permission by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi through letter No. 4791/DHC/Gaz./G-3/2023 dated 06.06.2023 to apply for LL.M. (Two Year) (Weekend Programme) offered by Gautam Buddha University, Greater Noida, Gautam Budh Nagar, U.P. The said permission letter also contained 3 conditions. **A copy of the**

aforesaid permission letter is annexed herewith as Annexure 1 for your kind reference.

2. It is further submitted that after obtaining the aforesaid permission, I had applied for the said LL.M. (Two Year) (Weekend Programme) and in compliance of the instructions mentioned in the aforesaid permission letter had duly intimated the date of entrance exam and viva-voce exam to the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi through letter/ email dated 23.06.2023 and after seeking leave from the competent authorities appeared in the entrance exam and viva-voce exam and has been finally selected for admission with All India Rank 3. **(Print out copy of the admit card, entrance result and final result downloaded from the website of the concerned University are annexed herewith conjointly and marked as Annexure 2).**
3. That, the counselling date for completing admission formality for deposition of fee is 22.07.2023. However I have sent an application to University authorities for the extension of time.
4. That, in para/condition no. 3 of the aforesaid permission letter by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi I was instructed to submit documentary proof of the claim that the attendance required can be met by attending weekend classes on Sunday and second Saturday without affecting disposal and maintainability of official punctuality. In this regard I have to respectfully submit as under:
 - (i) That, as per the information available on the website of the University Grant Commission, Gautam Buddha University is a state University and the University was Established by the Uttar Pradesh Gautam Buddha University Act 2002 UP Act No 9 of 2002. Approved by UGC under Section 12-B & NAAC accredited.
 - (ii) That, at page no. 2 of the prospectus of the University the programme is described as a weekend programme and on the page 36 of the prospectus the programme has been clearly mentioned as LL.M. (Two Year) **(working professional)**. Complete set of the prospectus was submitted by me with my



application dated 20.05.2023 however **photo copy of page 2 and page 36 of the prospectus are annexed herewith for ready reference and marked as Annexure 3.** ①

✓ (iii) That, it is on the basis of above informations mentioned in prospectus of the university, on oral inquiry the admission coordinator of the university informed me in the beginning that minimum percentage of attendance required is 75% and also said that since this LL.M. programme has been designed mainly for working professionals and since many candidates may not be able to attend classes on Saturday, the classes will also be held during vacations and in the evening hours of weekdays.


✓ (iv) That, recently the Gautam Budh University has issued a notice no. **GBU-029/Law/01/2023-527 dated 17.07.2023** which says that "classes of LL.M. (Two Year) (Weekend Programme) shall be conducted on weekend (Saturday & Sunday), holidays and during the vacations". **The said notice is annexed herewith as Annexure 4.**

✓ (v) That, recently the Gautam Budh University has also issued a tentative time table dated 17.07.2023 of first semester of the LL.M. (Two Year) (Weekend Programme). The time table shows that classes will also be conducted in the evening of week days between 7:00 PM to 9:00 PM. **The said tentative time table dated 17.07.2023 is annexed herewith as Annexure 5.** ②

✓ (vi) That, **the relevant pages of the copy of the ordinance containing course structure for LL.M. (Two Year) (Weekend Programme) offered by Gautam Budh University and Counselling cum Admission Schedule are also annexed herewith conjointly and marked as Annexure 6.**

✓ (vii) That, the Gautam Budh University is located near my residence in Greater Noida.

(viii) That, in view of the above submissions it is humbly submitted that I am certain and sure that I would be able to meet the attendance required to pursue the LL.M. (Two Year)



(Weekend Programme) without affecting disposal and maintainability of official punctuality.

5. Most respectfully I also undertake that I shall not let my official duty and punctuality be affected in any manner because of the fact that I would be pursuing the LL.M. (Two Year) (Weekend Programme).

The requisite details in the prescribed format for application for permission to pursue higher education and prospectus of the course was already submitted with the application dated 20.05.2023 for your kind perusal.

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**ORDINANCE FOR INTRODUCTION FOR LL.M. (WEEKEND PROGRAMME)
SCHOOL OF LAW, JUSTICE & GOVERNANCE
GAUTAM BUDDHA UNIVERSITY**

(A) INTRODUCTION:

Introduction of two year LL.M. Weekend Programme under Department of Law, Gautam Buddha University from session 2023 onwards.

(B) BOARD OF STUDIES:

Constitution, Power and Functions of Board of Studies will be as per GBU ordinance rules.

(C) ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:

- (i) The candidates shall be selected for admission to the LL.M. Weekend Programme on the basis of their *inter se* merit as announced in the result of the written test conducted by the GBU.
- (ii) The minimum eligibility requirement for appearing in the test shall be Law Degree or an equivalent degree from any University recognized by the UGC with not less than 50% marks in aggregate (45% in case of SC/ST candidates of Uttar Pradesh). However, those who are appearing in the final examination of the aforesaid Degree course or whose results are awaited may also appear, however such candidates shall have to produce a proof of having qualified the aforesaid degree course examination with the required percentage of marks generally on the date of their admission.
- (iii) All other conditions for admission will be as per GBU admission rules.

(D) FOREIGN NATIONALS/NON-RESIDENTIAL INDIANS/NRI SPONSORED:

- (i) Foreign Nationals/Non-Resident Indians (NRI) may be admitted to the LL.M. Programme provided that they fulfill the prescribed minimum eligibility requirements. They may be exempted from the written test.
- (ii) Only those foreign nationals/NRIs shall be admitted to the course, who have a valid visa to stay in India.
- (iii) The number of supernumerary seats for this category shall be not more than ten.

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(C) INTAKE AND RESERVATION

The intake shall be 30 students for the LL.M. programme in the State Government.

(D) FEE STRUCTURE:

The details of the fee structure shall be as follows:

(E) DURATION OF THE PROGRAMME:

The duration of the programme shall be two years. A student who has completed the LL.M. programme has to complete the course within a maximum period of two years from the date of admission to the LL.M. programme.
