Subject: Request for Permission to Pursue LL.M. Course on Dispute Resolution from Jindal Global Law School powered by upGrad, O.P. Jindal Global University, District Sonapat, Haryana

Sir,

Kindly refer to the captioned subject. In this context, it is submitted that I have applied for permission to pursue a Master of Law (LL.M.) course in Dispute Resolution from Jindal Global Law School, powered by upGrad, O.P. Jindal Global University, District Sonapat, Haryana while continuing my Judicial and Administrative work as a Judicial Officer.

Certain objections were raised on my application dated April 19, 2024 for permission to pursue the LL.M. course.

Regarding the objections raised, it is to submit that, as per the instructions and guidelines provided by the Hon'ble High Court Allahabad, I have not started the admission process for my LL.M. so far. I will start the admission process only after obtaining the due permission from the Hon'ble Court.

The LL.M. course on Dispute Resolution offered by O.P. Jindal University, primarily consists of pre-recorded lectures and virtual classes conducted on weekends. There are no day-to-day classes. In this connection, please refer to Page No. 28 of the prospectus, which is attached hereto for reference. It is mentioned in the prospectus that for this blended learning course, physical attendance is not needed and only classes on weekends will be done.

I am intending to take admission for academic session 2024-2025 which will be in virtual mode and is scheduled to be held on weekends, spanning 2-3 hours per week. The entire programme is structured into three trimesters, culminating in a duration of 12 months or one year.

I am also asked to explain the term Blended Learning. Blended learning is an approach to education in which traditional classes are supplemented with technology and learners take advantage of online resources. In the context of LL.M. through blended learning, there will be pre-recorded lectures that will be given to us for each trimester, and there will be online classes on weekends through which we can interact in-person with teachers through virtual mode.

I have attached my Declaration, Consolidated List of Universities Recognised by UGC, in which, at S.No. 280, the name of the above said University is mentioned, which means the said University is recognised by UGC.

this list is attached hereto for the reference. It is humbly requested that you please consider these details while processing my above request for permission.

In light of the aforementioned details, I respectfully request the Hon'ble High Court Allahabad to grant permission for the commencement of the LL.M. admission procedure at Jindal Global Law School, powered by upGrad, O.P. Jindal Global University, District Sonapat, Haryana, thereby enabling me to pursue advanced studies in law.

It is humbly requested to place my request before the Hon'ble Court for kind consideration.
