We would like to inform you that the LL M. programmes in Corporate & Financial Law (Blended Learning Programme), Intellectual Property & Technology Law (Blended Learning Programme), and Dispute Resolution (Blended Learning Programmes) of JGU are governed by all relevant UGC guidelines (i.e., the 1-year LL M. Guidelines) to the letter and should not be confused with a part-time or remote learning programme. The LL M. programmes are JGU-run programmes and upCraft actilitates the delivery of the programmes through their learning platform. These programmes fall squarely within the UGC LL M. Guidelines, and some of the features of these guidelines are set out below:

- The referenced LL.M. Programmes are following all relevant UGC guidelines, and each comprise 24 credits with 3 compulsory courses of 3 credits each (namely, Comparative Public Law, Law & Justice in the Globalizing World, and Legal Research Methodology), 6 specialized courses of 2 credits each, and a dissertation of 3 credits.
 The one-year duration of the LL.M. programmes is divided into three trimesters, with each week comprising 30 hours of learning time, inclusive of teaching hours, library work, and research hours.

Having said this, please note that this programme has been designed for working legal professionals and/or persons who are looking to advance their career in the corporate and financial law, intellectual property or arbitration and dispute resolution.

The LL.M. programmes are offered to students in a blended learning mode, comprising elements of recorded resources for asynchronous learning as well as interactive classes on weekends.

Should you, for any unforeseen circumstances, miss a session, the recorded lectures are designed to facilitate the coverage of any topics that may have been missed. It is highly recommended to attend live sessions to get the best out of this programme.
