Note:

- (1) JGU is a recognised university/higher educational institution by the University Grants Commission (UGC) and is fully empowered to offer all degree programmes. JGU has also received the then highest grade “A” from NAAC, besides being given the status of “Graded Autonomy” by the UGC. On 29 October 2020, JGU signed a memorandum of understanding (MOU) with the Ministry of Education, Government of India, and was conferred with the status of an ‘Institution of Eminence Deemed to be University’ under the UGC (Institution of Eminence Deemed to be Universities) Regulations, 2017 (IoE Regulations). Since then, JGU is governed independently by these regulations as per the MOU with the Ministry of Education, Government of India.
- (2) The LL.M. Blended Learning Programmes of JGU are governed by the relevant UGC guidelines (i.e., the 1-year LL.M. Guidelines).
- (3) The LL.M. programmes are offered to students in a blended learning mode, comprising elements of recorded resources for asynchronous learning as well as interactive classes. Therefore, attendance in all interactive classes conducted on weekends by the University is mandatory. The classes are held on weekends (Sundays) between the course start date and the end date for each course.
- (4) Each course has two internal assessments and one end-term examination. The end-term schedule for each trimester is listed above. The dissertation timelines will be communicated separately.
- (5) All the submissions are made on JGU’s University Management System at <https://ums.jgu.edu.in/>.
- (6) Reading & Revision Period may include a submission deadline for internal assessments.
- (7) As the course is yet to begin, these are tentative timelines, and additional details will be intimated to the students closer to the course start date.
